



Non-payment of COSRT Membership Fees

1. Annual Membership fees are to be paid by 1st January.
2. Members may pay by annual/monthly direct debit or direct BACS payment.
3. Failure to renew Membership by paying the relevant Membership Fees by the due date of 1st January will mean that thereafter membership is considered to have lapsed.
4. Non-payment of Membership fees leading to termination of membership will result in the need to reapply for membership. (Termination of membership leads to loss of Registration, Accreditation and if applicable UKCP registration.)
5. COSRT will give 21 days' notice of termination of membership due to non-fee payment.
6. If Members pay within this 21-day period, then Membership and associated benefits will be retained.
7. If Members fail to pay within this 21-day period, the individual's COSRT Membership will be formally terminated.
8. Termination of membership will mean that:
 - i. the member's name is removed from all COSRT membership lists, mailing lists, search engines, Registers and website.
 - ii. All reference to membership of COSRT must be removed from any of the individual's materials, website, stationery, cards etc. and from any other organisations' materials or websites. Failure to comply may result in legal action.
 - iii. Confirmation of termination of membership will be sent to the individual and UKCP will be notified if the member concerned is a UKCP registrant.
 - iv. COSRT reserves the right to inform other relevant individuals or organisations of the outcome of the Disciplinary Procedure.
